The Boulevards: Boundary Description – Beginning at the junction of Brinkerhoff Avenue and Maple Street, then heading east on Maple Street to the point of intersection with the rear property lines of the east side of Glenwood Blvd., then heading north along those rear property lines to the intersection with Park Avenue West, then turning west on Park Avenue to the west side of Brinkerhoff Avenue, and then heading south to the point of the beginning.

Sherman's Estate: Boundary Description – Enclosed by the boundaries of Sycamore Street, rear property lines of the south side of West Fourth Street but including 437 W. Fourth St, the rear property lines of the west side of Penn Avenue, and the rear property lines of lots on the south side of West Third Street.
